Belle Glos Meiom Pinot Noir, Sonoma County -Monterey - Santa Barbara, 2008

Tech: 13.9% Alcohol. 100% Pinot Noir (65% Sonoma Coast, 20% Monterey, and 15% Santa Barbara) fermented using punch-downs in open top fermenters. Medium purple in color with well formed legs; dry, medium-full-bodied and rich with freshly balanced acidity. Supple and juicy. Rich and ripe with a bit more red than black cherry berry fruit. Lovely earth, cocoa, and spice notes but still with a hint of cola. Supple in the mouth. This is the best Meomi yet.
